Dear Brother Knights, Families, and Friends:

<u>WHAT:</u> The Knights of Columbus New Mexico State Council (NMSC) are asking: We have an urgent request to raise \$25k (Supreme will match the other \$25k) for an ultrasound machine in Las Cruces, NM.

• Request Councils, Assemblies, individual families and friends of the Knights to contribute generously towards this effort and do so immediately

<u>WHY we're asking</u>: The abortion clinic at the center of the Dobbs v. Jackson Supreme Court case (that overturned Roe v. Wade) has relocated from Mississippi to our own back yard in Las Cruces, NM.

• Southwest Coalition for Life has been expecting this move and already has a pregnancy center (Guiding Star) right next to the abortion clinic in Las Cruces. What the pregnancy center needs is an ultrasound machine as soon as possible

The pride he has in his personal military service, his patriotism, his dedication to his Faith and Veteran causes and his consistent focus on the Assembly matters make his shoes difficult to step into. Thank you, John, for all you have done, but do not go too far!

As I make this commitment however, I want you all to understand that this will be my first time being a Faithful Navigator, and although it might be challenging, I know I am not doing this alone. There are men in this assembly with far more experience than I and I welcome your input. I hope each of you feel free to make suggestions and help steer this ship.

As we enter the new fraternal year, there are things I would like to focus on. This focus will be in concert with the efforts and direction provided of our Worthy Grand Knight Tom Plate. They include:

- Placing an emphasis on participation in Corporate Communions
 - It is great to see the Color Corps processing in and out of Church as they are the visible arm of the Knights to the parish. I also think it important to remember our deceased brethren at Corporate Communion.
 - However, these are secondary to what I believe is the more important reason for Corporate Communion, that is, re-enforcing to each other that we are bound together in the pledge of Unity and Fraternity and that we are brothers in our Faith.
- Working with the Catholic War Veterans (CWV)
 - The Knights at Prince of Peace parish have successfully worked together with the CWV group in the past and there should be no reason we cannot support the CWV when and where it makes sense.
 - Deacon Norbert has been elected to re-start the Catholic War Veterans chapter here in the ABQ/Rio Rancho area of NM after COVID destroyed CWV's programs. This is a great organization that does patriotic work in areas that the Knights of this Assembly have not yet been part of.

- Some of their efforts include:
 - Working to stop the closure of remote VA clinics throughout New Mexico
 - Working to re-start the BLUE MASS to honor, our vets, police, firefighters and first responders.
 - Establishing a veterans Mass which could be attended by anyone wishing to honor vets with the Celebrant to be a Veteran himself.
 - Collaborating with the patient advocacy office at the VA hospital on specific patient cases
 - Volunteering and supporting events at the Veterans Memorial
- Better Participation in Assembly and Council Events and Projects
 - I took physics, biology, chemistry in HS and college where I learned many of the laws of nature. There seems to be one law that my instructors failed to tell me about. That is, in an organizational setting, 20% of the members do 100% of the work. It is a law as unwavering as gravity! I would like to focus on trying to gain a bit more participation for our activities. There is so much more we could be doing if we had the hands to do it. From Worthy Lecturer SK Jimm White

"But I say to you love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you" Mathew 5:44

Jesus doesn't mince words does he!

There it is, right there in black and white. In those few simple words spoken by Jesus Christ lies the solution to everything that is going on in our world today. In verse 43 Jesus speaks of the opposites we see all around us, He speaks of the divide

In verse 43 Jesus speaks of the opposites we see all around us, He speaks of the divide Satan uses:

"You have heard that it was said 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy". Love and hate.

All through His ministry on earth, Jesus continually preaches that we replace hate with love. In fact, that is a theme that runs through the whole Bible, Old Testament and New. And yet, in these times, we find ourselves more and more replacing love with hate. What kind of love us Jesus talking about?

I was going through some of the stuff on the prayer table between the chairs Pam and I sit in when we do our daily prayers, getting ready to throw away some of the old church bulletins when I came across a short piece in the bulletin from February 20th written by Maria von Trapp. Maria von Trapp, who, with her husband, children and stepchildren, were the inspiration for the movie "The Sound of Music".

In this piece she talks about the many kinds of love the human heart will experience in a life time. The love of God and Church. The love of your parents and siblings, the love of your wife and children, the excitement of love when you fall in love with the woman you will marry, and the kind of love the two of you experience in your hearts as you grow together. The love for your old school, the love of country, the love of friends.

But none of these are the love Jesus commands of us. None of these quite fits what He is talking about. This is a different kind of love. In Maria's words, "it is very anxious and unemotional". I had to think about that for a while. How can love be unemotional? Then it came to me. This is a love born of respect for the dignity that our enemies basic humanity demands. This is a love that comes from the understanding that they too are Gods creation, whether they like it or not. In a very real sense this is an Agape Love, a love that we choose, of commitment and sacrifice, but not emotion. This calls us to give up our anger and replace it with this love. This calls us to come to middle and find the common ground that Tyler Perry once spoke of. This love calls us to forgive our persecutors, and that, *in these times*, makes this love one of the hardest things we will do.

There is a second part of this verse, "to pray for those who persecute us". In Psalm 51:12 we pray "A clean heart create for me, oh God; renew within me a steadfast spirit". In Ezekiel 36:26-27, we hear Gods promise: "I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit. I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh". This is the prayer Jesus is asking us to extend to those who persecute us. A prayer that God will place in our persecutors a pure heart and a steadfast spirit; a prayer for their conversion.

We know that when the God places in us a pure heart and steadfast spirit we truly feel the joy of God's love, and that is what we pray our persecutors will come to know as well. That is the purpose of the love we choose, the Agape Love that we choose for the good of others.

Nobody said this was going to be easy, Jesus certainly never said or promised it would be, but that's part of the love He asks of us. As Knights we are deep in this spiritual war with the secular world.

If you have seen the movie, "Hacksaw Ridge" you will remember the part, close to the end, when Private Desmond Doss, a conscious objector who wouldn't carry a rifle into battle, carries his wounded brothers off the battle field under intense fire, and after he brought one back, he would go back for another, and another, each time praying "Lord Jesus help me to bring back just one more"?

As Knights our charge is to do the same on this spiritual battlefield: Lord Jesus, help us to bring back just one more, just one more, just one more.....




