





## NOVEMBER 2023 SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

"'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or ill or in prison, and not minister to your needs?' He will answer them, 'Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me.'" (Gospel for Nov. 26, Mt 25:44-45)

The capacity to help those in need begins with clearness of vision. Are we sometimes blind to the plight of others? Do we find ourselves saying, "Lord, when did we see you…?" We must first see the "least ones" in our midst, and then recognize the face of Christ in them. Only then can we respond in love to provide the care they require. Lord, grant us the eyes to see.

## Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to raise your own awareness of those in need by learning more about efforts to help the poor in your community. Second, I challenge you to support the Food for Families or Coats for Kids Faith in Action program.

## **Questions for Reflection:**

Do you sometimes turn a blind eye to the poor? Do you try to recognize Christ in every human person you meet? Are you hesitant to share your blessings with others who have less?







# From Worthy Lecturer SK Jimm White

I was going through one of my desk drawers a few days ago and came across a pocket New Testament I carried in my backpack when I was going to Santa Fe every day. Folded up in the back was a little prayer card, I think it came from Fr. Carney. Every once in a while, he hands these out, randomly and for no apparent reason, but I like it.

This one talks about trust in God and his eternal capacity to forgive us, again and again ...

Let me share this with you, Pope Francis writes: *"It is not easy to entrust oneself to God's mercy, because it is an inscrutable abyss. But we must do it.* 

'Oh Father, if you knew my life you would not speak this way'.

Why, what have you done?

Oh, I have done terrible things!

All the better! Go to Jesus: He would be happy if you told Him these things! He forgets, He has a special capacity to forget. He forgets, He kisses you, He embraces you and he says to you: Neither do I condemn you; go and from now on sin no more, (John 8:11)'.

That is the only council He gives you.

After a month, we are in the same situation ... let us return to the Lord.

The lord never wearies of forgiving: never! We are the ones who grow weary of asking forgiveness. And let us ask for the grace to never weary of asking forgiveness because He never wearies of forgiving. Let us ask for that grace".

That was part of Pope Francis's homily at Vatican City, on March 18, 2013.

And so, here we are, as Pope Francis says, after a month we are in the same situation!

Every time I go to confession, I hear my dad's voice as I was growing up, "when are you going to learn?" And I fully expect at some point to hear the priest say "really Jimm, can't you think of something new to sin about?" Instead, what I hear, every time, without fail, is: "your sins are forgiven".

When we think of how hard it is for us to sometimes forgive, it makes me forever grateful for, and I am deeply in love with, our God, who so easily forgives.

In his comments on the Book of Joel in 406 AD, St. Jerome writes: "Do not despair of his mercy, no matter how great your sins, for great mercy will take away great sins".

Let us never lose sight of that by thinking that whatever we have done can't be forgiven: all we have to do is ask – again, and again, and again .....








## **STAR COUNCIL**

**<u>Receptionist(s)-Part time</u>** will welcome clients as they come to the pregnancy medical clinic, make sure forms and completed, entered, and filed, schedule appointments, and do basic office work. Client Advocacy training will be required and provided by PDL.

**Spanish-Speaking Client Advocates (Part-time)** will assist clients who are Spanish-speaking in our services, from pregnancy testing, options consultation, to case management. At this time, we are not seeing a high-volume of Spanish-speaking clients and so this will be an on-call position for a designated day and time-frame. We are looking for 10 volunteers to commit to 9-12:30 or 12:30-4 on any given day, Monday through Friday. Client Advocacy training will be required and provided by PDL.

<u>Weekend Cleaners</u> will do basic upkeep of building such clean bathrooms, sweep and mop floors, and vacuum.

<u>Office Assistance (part-time)</u> will fulfill basic office duties, filing, organizing, product ordering, printing, and mailing.

**Event Planning** will assist President and Community Outreach director in various tasks for our annual Gala, Galentine's, and other related events.




