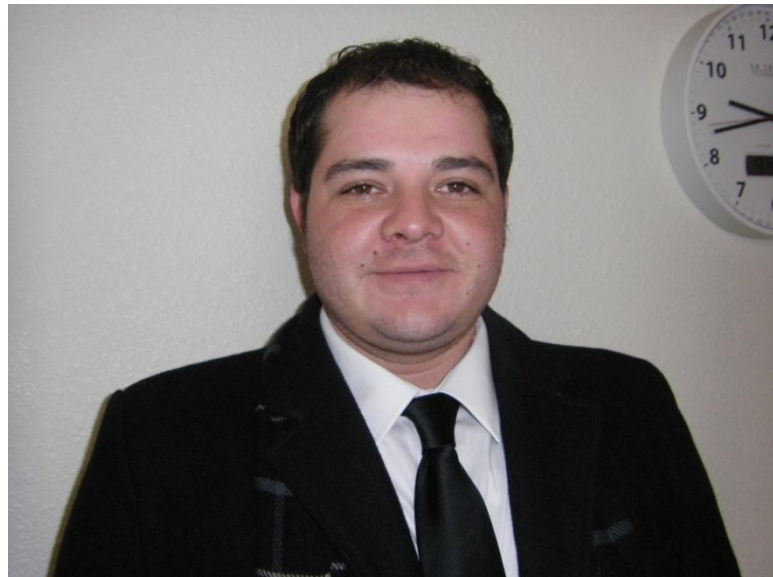

January is a very sad month in that the abortion mills are busy and January 22nd is the anniversary of when the killing of children in the womb became legal in the United States. However, lives can be saved if we resolve to pray and witness for life in the New Year. Please join me at the following events ...

- The **Holy Innocents Prayer Rally** will be held at 9 AM on Friday January 4th at Planned Parenthood's abortion mill at 701 San Mateo Blvd. Join the Sidewalk Advocates as a prayer partner and help save lives .
- The Incarnation Respect Life Ministry invites you to attend our meeting on Saturday January 5th after the 9 AM First Saturday Mass at the Church of the Incarnation in Rio Rancho. Our guest speaker will be **Ariana Nava, president of Students for Life at Rio Rancho High School**. Join us and hear how Ariana encourages students to get involved in saving lives. - The Annual **Sanctity of Life Awareness and Unity Day** will be held in Santa Fe on Wednesday January 16th. Hopeful

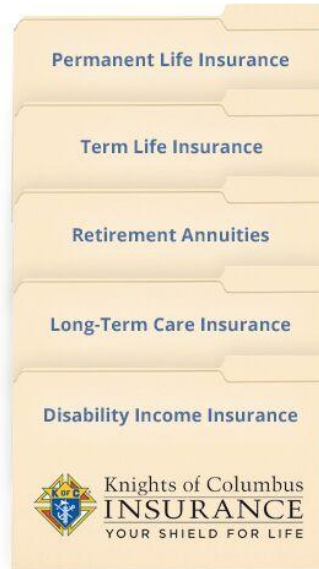
