Every once in a While

Every once in a while, I come back to this. It's good perspective to keep me humble, centered, and appreciative of God, especially when I'm in pain like I have been recently. Some of you will recognize this, I have used it before, but I think it's worth hearing again. Fr. Carney sent this to me some time back, but it's believed to have been authored by an unknown soldier during the Civil War. Here it is:

I asked God

"I asked God for strength, that I might achieve; I was made weak that I might learn humbly to obey.

I asked for health that I might do great things; I was given sickness that I might do better things.

I asked for riches that I might be happy; I was given poverty that I might be wise.

I asked for power to have the praise of others; I was given weakness to feel the need for God.

I asked for all things that I might enjoy life; I was given life that I may enjoy all things. I received nothing I asked for - but everything I hoped for.....

Almost despite myself, my unspoken prayer was answered: I am, among all people, most richly blessed."



September 2022 Supreme Chaplain's Monthly Challenge

"I tell you, in just the same way there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who have no need of repentance." (Gospel for Sept. 11, Lk 15:7)

This Gospel reading links the parable of the lost sheep with the parable of the prodigal son. Together these parables remind us that God constantly seeks us whenever we go astray. We are all sinners, and like the prodigal son we must wake up, repent and return to the Father. When we do this, we find that he runs to meet us. My brother Knights, let us create some joy in heaven. Let us recognize that we are sinners in need of repentance and ask the Father for his forgiveness.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to watch the "Sacramental Life" episode of the Into the Breach video series, particularly reflecting on the importance of the sacrament of reconciliation. Second, I challenge you to participate in the Faith in Action Sacramental Gifts program.

Questions for Reflection:

Are there ways you see yourself as a lost sheep, a prodigal son? What concrete steps can you take to overcome sinful habits and avoid temptations? Do you "come home" to the Father to receive his mercy and forgiveness in the sacrament



THE OBLIGATION TO ATTEND MASS HAS BEEN RESTORED!

For most of the COVID-19 pandemic, Archbishop Wester had granted dispensation for the faithful from attending Mass on Sunday.

This was done out of an abundance of caution—especially for the medically compromised and elderly.

While he kept the dispensation in place for much longer than the mask mandate, he has now lifted the dispensation. To willfully and purposefully miss Sunday Mass is to commit a grave sin.

The usual exceptions are if someone is ill, you are the caretaker of an ill person, or if you absolutely cannot make Mass because of work obligations. If we miss Mass with good reason, we should make more time for prayer than normal.

Holy Mother Church has the authority to make such a precept but does it out of love, with one agenda. That is to get us to heaven.


