Veterans Day

They say a cat has 9 lives. I have had more than 30 or more dear death experiences serving my country in Vietnam. God is the reason I survived. Early in my life, my aunt raised me until she died. But I remember her motherly guidance and keeping God in my life. My life changed in my teens when I was homeless and living under a bridge for 8 months in Chicago.

At age 17, alone, homeless, dirty, hungry, no friends, I didn't understand why I was living like this. I was not a pessimist, rebel, or mentally sick, I just wanted to live like everyone else in a home with food, water, and a roof over my head. An Army recruiter rescued me and treated me like a human being.

I joined the Army and I felt like I belonged to humanity again. When I was sent to Vietnam, the enemy's (Charlie) tactics employed to kill us were mind boggling. What I suffered and went through was life threatening. We were always in the jungle, day or night fighting. But it was worse at night; not seeing the enemy during a firefight and sometimes not knowing where the enemy was located was confusing. Who could believe these stories as they were so surreal? Charlie (Viet Cong) threw a grenade at me and it exploded between the two of us. I was wounded. My chest popped out, but I didn't feel pain. I was patched up and after 30 days, I went back on patrol. I was also hit by a sniper bullet in my left and I was out for a week. I went back on patrol afterwards.

I learned during my stay in Vietnam that Charlie was just a farmer recruited to fight us. It made me sad to know they were ordinary people used by the Viet Cong.

I received the Bronze Star, two Purple Hearts, the CID Badge, the Silver Wing Paratrooper Medal, and the Vietnamese Bronze Cross for Gallantry. I had 13 medals in all, but they don't really mean as much as the men I saved in my squad. Now in 2022, as far as I know, I am the only one still living from my squad. God was watching over me and is still watching over me.

God bless America.





Mary, Wisdom, and the Church

CONSECRATION to ST. JOSEPH



"Hail favored one! The Lord is with you". Lk 1:28

I always thought the first time we hear of Mary is in the New Testament when the Angel Gaberial comes to her to announce she will be the Mother of God. Most of my Catechism from my early days with the Baltimore Catechism, and a great deal of discussion about Mary since then, taught me this story, but never mentions Mary prior to this event, and I don't believe she is mentioned anywhere else in the New Testament before this greeting.

Is this the first time we know of Mary in the Bible? There are certainly many references to Mary in the Old Testament;

In Isiah we read: "Behold, a virgin has conceived and will bear a son, and shall call his name Emmanuel, which means God with us."

But let's go back even further, to the beginning in Proverbs, the Book of Wisdom, and Sirach.

In Proverbs we read: "The Lord begot me, the beginning of His works, the forerunner of His deeds of long ago. From of old I was formed, at the first, before the earth".

When you read this passage and others in Proverbs, Wisdom and Sirach it seems obvious the authors are talking about Mary. The similarities in characteristics and attributes of Wisdom in the Old Testament and Mary in the New Testament cannot be overlooked. "Wisdom" in these scriptures is treated as if it is a person, a woman.

For the last 1000 years or so the Church has considered that this is in fact a "type" of Mary. I'm not sure I know what they mean by "type", but I would suggest this is the Spirit, the essence of Mary that was created before all else. So, we could say the writers in the Old Testament knew the essence, the persona of Mary without knowing the person of Mary.

Mary doesn't become person until her own Immaculate Conception, and all the essence of Mary over the ages becomes the person of Mary who will be the vessel of God to bring God, Jesus, into this world as a person.



Lord, make me an instrument of Your Peace: Where there is hatred, let me sow love: Where there is injury, pardon; Where there is doubt. faith: Where there is despair, hope; Where there is darkness, light; And where there is sadness, joy.

O Divine Master, Grant that I may not so much seek To be consoled as to console; To be understood, as to understand; To be loved, as to love;

For it is in giving that we receive, It is in pardoning that we are pardoned,

And it is in dying that we are born to Eternal Life. Amen The Gospels tell us that Mary was there when Jesus was born, was there when Jesus started his ministry at the Wedding at Cana and was there at the foot of the Cross when Jesus died. Others come and go thru the Gospels, but only Mary is there for all three.

There, with His mother, Mary, and John the Apostol at the foot of the Cross, Jesus says something that from that time on has people asking if he had a brother and Mary another son, which by extension, would mean Mary did not continue being a virgin after the birth of Christ.

In his book "Reclaiming Vatican II" Fr. Blake Britton speaks to this and for the first time I understand the correct answer to the question.

"Woman, behold your son". Fr, Britton explains that Jesus isn't telling Mary to take care of her son in the sense that John is her son the way Jesus is. With these words Jesus is making Mary the Church, not a member of the Church, but *the* church in persona and as person. Christ is making an official decree as to the role of Mary in Christianity. She *is* the Church. This is why the Church is referred to in the feminine.

Then he speaks to John, "Behold your Mother". With these words, Jesus is referring to John as the faithful of the Church. So now the Church and the faithful of the Church are called together in the way the Church will always be the Love of God to her faithful, and the faithful will always love their Mother, the Church.

We as Knights of Columbus have a special devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, and now we understand our devotion to the Church. Now we understand that because Mary is without sin that the Church is without sin. Now we understand the two parts that come together to become one.

Through all the scandals that have plagued the Church in past years, we understand that we, the faithful of the Church are capable of sin, and that the Church, because it is without sin, is our pathway to God.


Now we understand, from this perspective, the complete importance of Mary in God's plan all the way back to the beginning.

God created the essence of Mary to be Wisdom, to be a pathway to God. Mary becomes a person and bears into the world God, in the person of Jesus. Christ decrees Mary as the Church and is, again, our pathway.

Either in essence or in person, Mary was then, is now, and always will be a pathway to Jesus.



"For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." (Gospel for Dec. 18, Mt 1:20-21)




