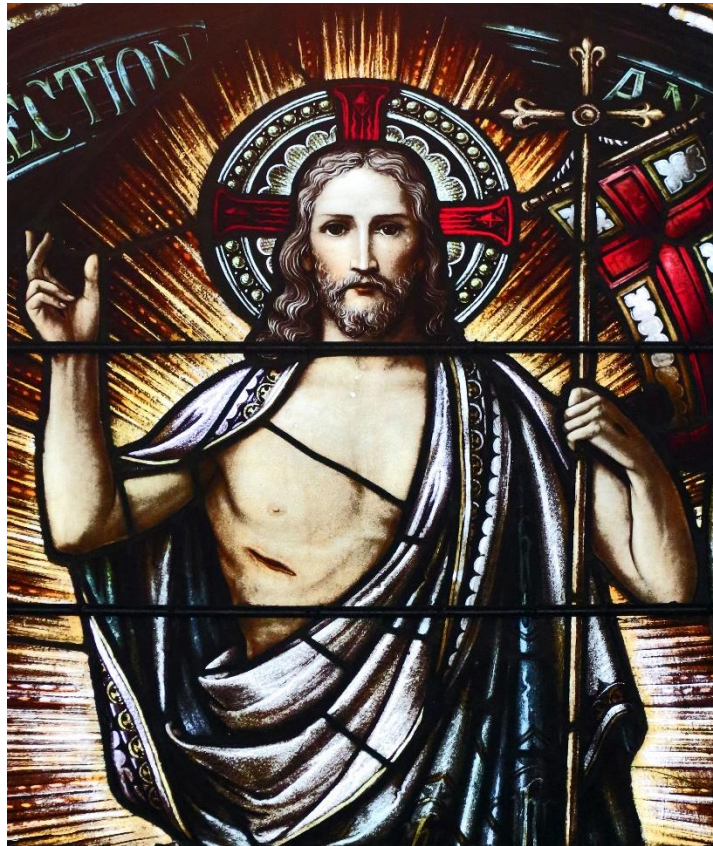

From Worthy Lecturer SK Jimm White

“Before I can live with other folks, I've got to live with myself. The one thing that doesn't abide by majority rule is a person's conscience.”

— Harper Lee, To Kill a Mockingbird

We have all, at one time or another, done or said something really stupid? I mean the type of thing when you wake up in the morning you really do not want to look at the face that looks back at you? That is a moment of conscience, and it's an important opportunity to learn from that mistake.

It may well have tried to visit with you when you were saying things you later regret, or doing things that you were not very proud of. At those moments when our conscience is waving its arms, we simply tell our conscience to shut-up and sit down, or, more likely, simply ignore it.

A person's conscience is an internal monitor that kicks in when something is just not right. It is a nuisance. If ignored we can become perpetual two year olds screaming for our way.

However, if we respect our conscience and listen to it at the time the alarm gong is going off, we tend to have fewer stupid moments, and develop a thing called **integrity**.

Our conscience helps us understand that our dumb acts are ours, and in spite of feeling someone else caused our dumb acts we still have to accept responsibility for what we did...and if necessary, make amends for it.

Where does our conscience come from? Well, we were born with it. It's kinda like a lump of clay waiting to be formed, by parents who teach us right from wrong, from others like priests, teachers, family, and our surroundings.

But that lump of clay already has some basic programming installed. That was installed by God. Bishop Barron made the comment in one of his videos a few years ago that at our very basic level in our DNA, we are wired for God. It strikes me this is the best explanation for a conscience I've heard.

And it also strikes me that for a mentally normal person, (I know, that leaves a LOT of room for interpretation), it takes some doing to ignore our conscience.

Living with ourselves is an art form, a dance, a balancing act and a challenge...it is easier however, if we learn to live with a well listened to conscience.
