

Letter from Archbishop Wester on Chapter 11

From State Deputy John Brault



Brothers,

I've just come back from the Mid-Year Meeting of State Deputies in Houston, Texas. We discussed a lot of great ideas and best practices that have the potential to make a big impact here in our jurisdiction.

One that I'm really excited about is a new prospecting system that we can use for all kinds of things: church drives, men's conferences, pancake breakfasts, spaghetti dinners, fish fries – really any event where we have potential members.

We'll talk more about it at the mid-year organizational meeting, but it's a really simple process. **Supreme will build a** <u>custom</u> **Prospect Landing Page for your council that you can use on a phone, a tablet or a computer**. You can ask potential members if they're interested in learning more about the Knights, and you can enter their information into the form in a matter of seconds. They'll immediately get a personalized email signed by you the grand knight, and encouraging them to join the Knights and reference your council by name and number.

The form will also auto-generate an email to you, which will give you all of the information given for each person that signs up, and it will enroll them in an email marketing campaign that will help tell them more about the Knights and what we do over time (Don't worry, they can unsubscribe at any time).

It's a great system! *This can be a real game changer in the way we prospect. I would encourage every council to get out in front of this and request your own page immediately.* The attached document explains it in more detail. All you need to do is go to info.kofc.org/pagerequest.

KEEP CHRIST IN CHRISTMAS

A Higher Purpose

Promote the true spirit of Christmas in our homes, schools, parishes and communities. Knights of Columbus councils evangelize society through their faithful acts, celebrations and a variety of activities.

Overview

The Knights of Columbus offers multiple activities that promote Christmas and the season of Advent in their proper context: Journey to the Inn, Light Up for Christ, Crèche or Advent Wreath Blessing, and the Christmas Poster Contest. These programs are centered on the example of the Holy Family and the Nativity of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

The new Keep Christ in Christmas program brings all related activities together under one umbrella. It encourages councils to compel their neighbors to shift from a preoccupation with materialism to the light of Christ and the spirit of giving. Activities include whatever efforts best suit the parish and community of a particular council and do not need to originate from the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council

Action Steps - Conduct activities promoting the true spirit of Christmas and the importance of Christ's birth and message.

If needed, order the *Keep Christ in Christmas* (KCIC) program resources through Supplies Online, the supply ordering portal available on Officers Online.

Prior to each event you conduct, consider crafting and distributing a tailored release to local media. Build public interest for your KCIC program! Promote all activities in your parish and larger community through a variety of efforts:

- Prominently display promotional posters (which can be made specifically by your council or ordered through Supplies Online)
- o Bulletin announcements
- o Pulpit announcements
- o Posting on your council and parish website / social media pages


Wear Knights of Columbus-branded apparel to all your KCIC activities and have the council membership director bring brochures and membership documents (including *Prospect Cards* #921A). Do not forget that this event is a recruiting opportunity!

Enlist a fellow Knight or community member to photograph the event.

To gain credit for your program, complete the associated reporting forms at the end of the Christmas season and submit them to the Supreme Council Department of Fraternal Mission. Remember to retain copies for your council records.

- At the end of the fraternal year, complete your *Columbian Award Application* (#SP-7)

OUR MISSION

Project Defending Life aims to help women address the challenges of pregnancies that cause them to abortionvulnerable, to provide a chapel for prayer and contemplation for the pro-life community, and to provide support for peaceful, prayerful witness for life and activities such as Sidewalk Advocates, 40 Days for Life, etc.

Project Defending Life is a Catholic-based ministry that answers the challenge of Pope John Paul II's encyclical, the Gospel of Life. We are committed to defending the sacredness of human life from conception to natural death, focused specifically on ending abortion. Our first priority is to give aid and comfort to abortionvulnerable women in unplanned and crisis pregnancies, so that they ultimately choose life and carry their babies to term. We serve the greater Albuquerque and Santa Fe areas of Northern New Mexico, within the Archdiocese of Santa Fe, and collaborate with other pro-life efforts in the state of New Mexico and throughout the United States.

OUR HISTORY

Since the landmark Supreme Court decision in 1973, pro-life advocates have worked and prayed to end the tragedy that is abortion. Albuquerque is known as "the abortion capitol of the Southwest," for its unrestricted access to abortion services up to the day of birth.

In the 1980s, Brother Mathias Barrett (founder of the Good Shepherd Center and the Barrett Home for unwed mothers) started a ministry to pray in front of abortion clinics. This ministry became known as "Project Life," and was devoted to offering pregnant women help and alternatives to abortion.

In 2006, Fr. Stephen Imbarrato revived the ministry and worked with a board of directors to rename and establish the ministry as Project Defending Life, a tax-exempt, not-for-profit organization dedicated to educating the public about abortion and how it hurts women, as well as providing services to abortion-vulnerable women.

Now located just 350 feet from Albuquerque's Planned Parenthood facility and under new leadership, Project Defending Life has become a pro-life center that houses Women's Pregnancy Options (a pregnancy resource center), the local chapter of Sidewalk Advocates for Life, and the Holy Innocents Chapel.

OUR SOLUTION

Generally a woman will choose to have an abortion to solve an underlying problem. Through our program, Women's Pregnancy Options, our goal is to help them solve that problem and choose life for their unborn baby. We do this by identifying their immediate needs, establishing goals to help redirect their focus and overcome mental, emotional, physical, and spiritual barriers, and advocating for self-confidence and Independence

Project Defending Life is a non-profit organization that is almost completely donor based. Your donations help keep the lights on but, more importantly, they help save lives. Please consider making a tax-deductible donation to help our mission.

Hopeful




