Eight Signs you are under Spiritual Attack

In the same way that the Holy Spirit is constantly speaking to us, Satan and his evil minions are constantly tempting us. The Holy Spirit can only help us if we open our hearts, minds, and souls through prayer and discernment to Him. Satan can only 'make' us sin if we give in to his temptations. We are all under constant attack from the devil and his evil spirits. Until you accept this fact, you cannot possibly be strong enough to fight back. The question is not 'When will Satan attack me?' it is 'How is Satan attacking me right now?!' The devil is real and if you are deceived in thinking that he does not exist then you are giving him complete control over your soul.

How often do you find yourself getting out of peace with your wife, your children, your co-workers, your clients, or your friends? How about people with liberal views, bad drivers, or those self-absorbed narcissistic people who care about no one except themselves? Satan even has a way of distracting our thoughts when we are praying or reading the Bible. There are many signs that you are under Spiritual Attack.

- 1. Lack of spiritual passion. The enemy comes to steal your tenacity for the things of God. Suddenly your prayer life seems stalled. Your commitment is tested and you can't seem to push though. Do you feel like you are just going through the motions?
- 2. **Frustration.** The enemy uses a variety of circumstances to oppress your mind and bring great frustration. Do you find yourself on edge and anxious?
- 3. **Confusion and Distraction.** Satan will work extremely hard to distract and confuse your mind. In today's secular driven society, we have cell phones, tablets, computers, TV, radio, etc. This constant noise keeps us from the Lord and we need to get away from the noise daily and just listen to the silence...it is through this silence that the Holy Spirit can speak to us. The Adoration Chapel is a wonderful place to find this silence. There is an article in the recent *Columbia* magazine called "The Age of Noise.' If you haven't read it, I suggest you find the time.
- 4. Lack of peace. Satan bombards our minds continuously with temptations so that he can steal away our peace from the Holy Spirit. Our minds become irritated and exhausted and when we give in to temptation and sin the enemy further bombards our mind to make us not feel worthy of His grace.
- 5. **Frequently sluggish and tired.** A lack of energy and vitality are often the result of an extended attack. Certainly, these issues can occur with natural problems like lack of sleep or health battles; however, the root cause is the effect of a prolonged attack by the devil.
- 6. **Strong urge to give up.** Every one of us is born with unique purpose as God created a purpose for each of us. He gave each of us a unique gift and His grace to fulfill that plan. Simply put, the enemy hates when we are following in our Lord's footsteps. He will do all that he can to take you away from your destiny. During an attack, he will overwhelm you with thoughts and desires to just give up and abandon your post!
- 7. Drawn back towards prior sin or addictions. In a long spiritual battle, you will be pulled back towards negative bondages that you have broken free from. The enemy wants to enslave you once again in your prior bondage. If he can discourage you bad enough to give into that prior addiction or sin, he will shame and condemn you causing you to spiral deeper down into defeat.
- 8. Questioning your direction and the call that was once so clear. As the devil attacks you, he begins to give you reasons to give up on everything that God has called you to do. He will use confusion, shame, intimidation, and a variety of evil schemes to create a cloud of uncertainty in your life.

Four Keys to Freedom

Once you recognize the attack, you must begin to rise up in the faith and authority that Jesus has given you. Rebuke the attack and break its power over your life. Remember that Jesus gave us His power and authority over all demons and to heal diseases (Luke 9:1). There are three keys to your freedom.

- 1. Break it with faith: (Heb. 11:6). "And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him"
- 2. Break it with prayer: (Eph. 6:18-19). "With all prayer and petition, pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints, and pray on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel"
- 3. Break it with resistance: (James 4:7). "Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you."
- 4. Break it with silence: (Isaiah 30:15) "For thus said the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel: By waiting and by calm you shall be saved, in quiet and in trust shall be your strength." The Hebrew translation for quiet in this verse not only carries the sense of inner silence, but inner peace as well. Our salvation and strength doesn't come through noise and much talking, but by cultivating what the Greeks call hesychia serene interior silence.

The devil loves to remain hidden. He deceives and tries to fly under the radar, but the Holy Spirit is shining His powerful light upon these attacks! We must open your eyes and realize that if we don't first know that we are under attack, we cannot possibly break off or defend ourselves against the attack!

Jericho Walk 2017


The Assembly Color Corp participated in the Jericho Walk on Good Friday, April 14, 2017.

One of the most successful of the Order's initiatives in this area is the **Ultrasound Initiative** though which councils (both state and local) partner with the Supreme Council in provide sharing the cost of purchasing ultrasound machines for pregnancy resource centers.

What we choose to do, or not do, about abortion, euthanasia, human cloning and embryonic research impacts lives for generations to come. Take action now and support a culture that values human life at all stages.

1. Volunteer

Your valuable time can save precious lives. Contact a local pro-life pregnancy center to find out how you can help women choose life and turn away from abortion. You can also support programs that work with women who have been physically and emotionally wounded by abortion.

2. Educate


