SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE March 2026

So Thomas, called Didymus, said to his fellow disciples, “Let us also go to die with him.” (Gospel for March 22, Jn 11:16)

Look at the bravery of Thomas! Jesus had just announced his intention to travel to Judea, where he had narrowly escaped getting stoned to death. Given the potential danger ahead, Thomas seems prepared for martyrdom. Later, of course, he and the other disciples would flee as Jesus was arrested, and Thomas would doubt reports of Jesus’ resurrection. As fallible humans, our strength and resolve sometimes collapse into weakness. May we always seek the courage to follow Jesus faithfully, even when the going gets tough.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, as we continue through Lent, I challenge you to pray the Stations of the Cross each week — in your parish community, with your family or individually — with the intention of receiving the courage to suffer for Christ. Questions for Reflection:



My Argument for Death:

It seems like lately there are more funerals than normal, whatever normal is, and I have to agree. We have seen many of our Knights pass, more in the last few years than before, and it raises our questions of our mortality. It asks the question none of us really want to ask:

Am I ready to die? Is our soul ready for our bodies to die? And I think, in that question, is this: have we learned anything from their passing. Does their passing have any meaning for us?

I like to think so, especially as we gain in years and, I certainly hope, grow in wisdom.

When I was a police officer I didn't give much thought to my own death, which is ironic since my profession had a higher chance of that than most others, except of course those in combat. But I was young, and as most of us remember, when we were young, we were invincible, and for most of us we pulled that off quite nicely.

I saw a lot of death in those years, most people I didn't know, but some I did, including my daughter. Maybe I'm just strange – but their deaths seemed to instill in me a deeper appreciation of my life, a deeper understanding that we don't have enough time.

Working in a hospital during Covid, I saw a lot of death, and I saw the impact on those who worked so hard to save those patients. And still, it gave me deeper appreciation of my life, a deeper understanding that we don't have enough time.

As part of emergency management during that time, I was in the daily safety and status meeting held at 08:00 every morning. From different department heads we learned the status of the patients in the hospital, and got a number of those we had lost over night. And we always ended the meeting with a prayer, (we could do that, we were a Catholic hospital).

But one prayer one of those mornings pretty said it all:

"We come together to seek meaning beyond our limited selves. We come together to seek a spirit that binds together the scattered threads of our humanity; a thread that binds us together in sympathy, in understanding, in love; a thread that weaves the past, present, and future together and unites the fragments of our existence into a meaningful whole.

Since we have felt the sense of death, since we have borne its dread, life has grown more dear. Since we have felt the sense of death, the gift of life is more a jewel, and the thread that binds us together is much more precious.

And, since we have gathered to honor the memories of those departed, and to recognize the ongoing thread of life that carries us into our future, let our hearts and minds and spirits be filled with gratitude for all those who give meaning to our lives. In the spirit of love and joy, may Gods presence grace us.”

My brothers, do we take the time to look at our lives, have we said “I love you” enough to our wife’s, our children, to our families, to our God?

How ever much time we have left, we still don’t have enough time.

As we are reminded in our Exemplification:

Tempus Fugit – Memento Mori.

Time flies – Remember death.
