FORGIVENESS

MT 18:21-35

"The Kingdom of heaven may be likened to a king who decided to settle accounts with his servants. When he began the accounting, a debtor was brought before him who owed him a huge amount."

Note that this debtor owed him a HUGE amount of money. This wasn't some petty debt. This debtor was also one of the King's servants.

"Since he had no way of paying it back, his master ordered him to be sold, along with his wife, his children, and all his property, in payment of the debt."

Imagine being told by your boss that you owed the company a lot of money (or cost the company a lot of money) and that not only were you going to be fired but you would also lose your wife, your children, your house, and all of your other possessions since you couldn't repay the debt.

"At that, the servant fell down, did him homage, and said, 'Be patient with me, and I will pay you back in full.'"

Moved with compassion the master of that servant let him go and forgave him the debt."

Sometimes we have to humble ourselves and ask for forgiveness. We must get beyond our pride and at times literally beg our brothers and sisters for forgiveness. If we do not show that we are truly sorry, how can we expect to be forgiven? We can't just expect others to have pity on us when we do wrong.

"When that servant had left, he found one of his fellow servants who owed him a much smaller amount. He seized him and started to choke him, demanding, 'Pay back what you owe.' Falling to his knees, his fellow servant begged him, 'Be patient with me, and I will pay you back.' But he refused. Instead, he had him put in prison until he paid back the debt."

How callous and shallow can a person be to be forgiven by someone that they have wronged in a major way just to turn around and not forgive another person who has committed a lesser sin against them? Not only did the first servant not forgive the lesser servant, but he also had him punished for the exact same crime that he had committed.

"Now when his fellow servants saw what had happened, they were deeply disturbed, and went to their master (the King) and reported the whole affair. His master summoned him and said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you your entire debt because you begged me to. Should you not have had pity on your fellow servant, as I had pity on you?'"

"Then in anger his master handed him over to the torturers until he should pay back the whole debt. So will my heavenly Father do to you, unless each of you forgives your brother from your heart."

We must always remember the debt that Jesus Christ paid for our debts...for our sins! Every single one of our sins will be forgiven by Him if we just get down on our knees and beg his forgiveness. In the same way, we must forgive our brothers and sisters for the sins they commit against us **when they ask to be forgiven!** If you don't forgive your brothers and sisters, then Jesus is telling us that we will surely be 'tortured until we pay back our entire debt!'

Supreme Knight visits New Mexico

Supreme Knight Carl Anderson was in Gallup, NM at the end of Holy Week on official business.

He attended the Evening Mass of Our Lord's Supper at Sacred Heart Cathedral presided over by Bishop James Wall during which an honor guard composed of color corps members from assemblies in northeast Arizona and western New Mexico who are in the Diocese of Gallup participated in the procession and recession at the Mass. Color corps members were invited to a dinner at the K of C Hall, met with the SK and posed for a group photo before the Mass.

John H. Reddin Province VSM Michael Kingman provided oversight of the combined AZ/NM district honor guard participation in the Holy Thursday Mass. Supreme Knight in New Mexico.

Honor guards at wakes/funeral Masses and liturgical ceremonies are the most frequent requests made of assembly color corps members. While honor guard requests for parish liturgical events are routinely made in advance, the death of a loved one is unpredictable and comes on its own timeline. The new Color Corps Drill Manual states ...“Without exception, honors by the Honor Guard shall be offered to deceased Sir Knights, their family members, Council members and to their immediate family members provided a request is made.

It must be distinctly understood that the wishes of the family of the deceased member are paramount and will be given the fullest consideration. Faithful Navigators are the focal point for requests.

Uniform Notes

New Fourth Degree uniforms are in the pipeline for delivery and the new manual details wear criteria along with color photos. Please focus on getting your new berets in shape for wearing as it requires time and effort.- The revised New Mexico district guidelines to supplement or clarify color corps procedures and wear of Regalia/Full Regalia is nearing completion.

The new Fourth Degree Color Corps Drill Manual can only be downloaded in .pdf format from <http://www.kofc.org/en/members/for-members/color.html>; hard copies are not yet available for ordering from K of C supply.

The biennial NM District Assembly gathering will convene on Saturday, April 21, 2018 in Albuquerque at the Lamy Building, 2800 San Mateo NE starting at 10:00 a.m. Those Sir Knights who are interested in being considered for selection by Supreme for the position of Master of the Fourth Degree (MFD) for New Mexico should be prepared to make their pitch to meeting attendees.

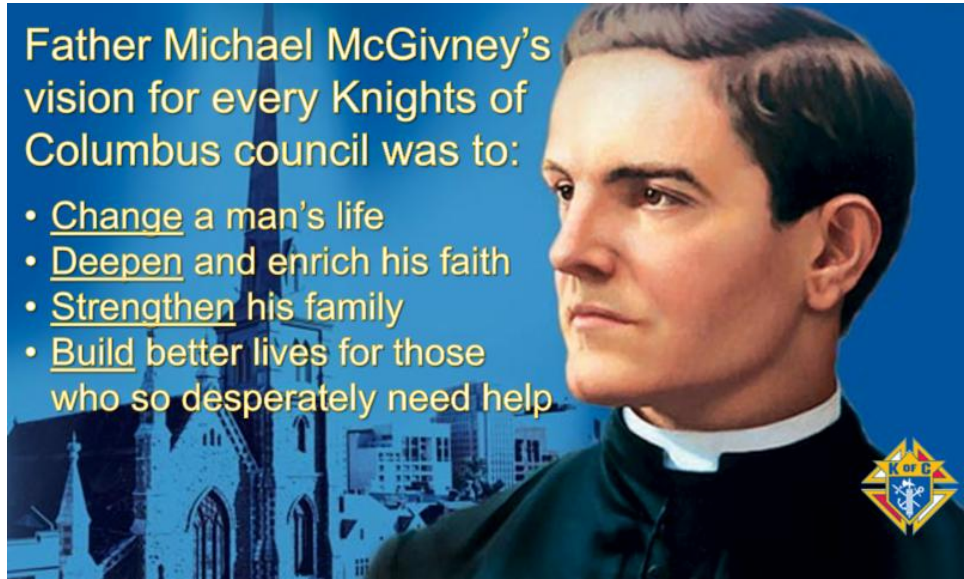

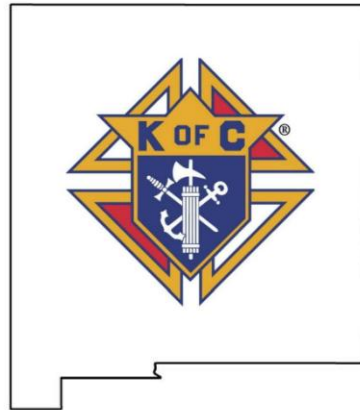

Did You Know ?

WAR AND PEACE: 1941-1950



By the time Pearl Harbor was attacked and the United States entered World War II in 1941, a K of C welfare program for servicemen had been well established by Canadian Knights, built and modeled on the Knights' World War I work. In the United States, the Order's outreach to soldiers was conducted through the National Catholic Community Service organization, which itself modeled many of its programs on the Knights' war efforts.

At the Supreme Convention in 1944, the Order established a \$1 million trust fund for the children of members who died or became disabled in World War II. Following the end of the war in 1945, the Order turned its attention to the growing threats of communism and fascism. To combat these dangers, the Knights launched in 1946 the Crusade for the Preservation and Promotion of American Ideals, which published books and pamphlets to educate the public on "the perils of communism."

Meanwhile, the postwar years saw a membership boom for the Order in the Philippines. Jesuit Father George J. Willmann envisioned the Knights as the premiere lay society in the Philippines and set about establishing new councils and recruiting new members. He appealed to the Supreme Council in 1947 for permission to establish three new councils there and served as the country's first district deputy. By the time Supreme Knight Luke E. Hart visited Manila in 1955, the Order had expanded to include 50 Filipino councils.

1941: When the U.S. enters World War II, the Order's outreach to soldiers is conducted via the National Catholic Community Service organization. The NCCS models many of its programs on the Order's successful WWI efforts.

1944: The Order creates a \$1 million trust fund for the education of children of members who lost their lives in or as a result of World War II. This evolves into the current scholarship fund for use at Catholic colleges and universities in the United States and Canada.

1945: John E. Swift is elected supreme knight. Among his first initiatives is to authorize funding for full-page advertisements in 12 major U.S. newspapers and five Canadian papers highlighting the dangers of communism. The ad offers a free copy of Msgr. Fulton J. Sheen's pamphlet, "Communism, the Opium of the People."

1946: The Order launches its Crusade for the Preservation and Promotion of American Ideals. Educational pamphlets on communism and the dangers of secularism are published and distributed. By August 1948, there are more than 1,300 K of C discussion groups.

1947: Several hundred radio stations broadcast K of C-sponsored programs with the titles "Safeguards of America" and "Foundations of Our American Ideals."
